Items to include: ☐ Flashlight and extra batteries ☐ Portable cell phone charger □ Non-perishable food/energy bars ☐ Infant formula, diapers, wipes ☐ Bottled water: plastic so it won't break if frozen □ Booster cables ☐ Hand sanitizer: 60% alcohol (can also be used for de-icing frozen locks) ☐ Emergency flares ☐ High visibility vest ☐ Candle in a deep metal can and waterproof matches ☐ Heavy blanket/sleeping bag □ Extra clothing & footwear: seasonal ☐ Work gloves ☐ First aid kit ☐ Shovel ☐ Fire extinguisher ■ Whistle ☐ Spare fuel container □ Road maps □ Emergency contact numbers ☐ Emergency help sign for dashboard
