

Contest Rules

City of St. Albert – Clean and Green RiverFest Pre-Registration Draw **(the “Contest”)**

This Contest is intended for residents of Alberta only and will be interpreted according to the laws of Alberta. This Contest is being conducted by the City of St. Albert (the “Sponsor”).

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN.

HOW TO ENTER

The Contest begins on or about 12:00 a.m. (MT) August 1, 2026, and ends with all entries submitted in online by 11:59 PM (MT) on September 17, 2026 (hereinafter referred to as the “Contest Period”).

To enter, participants must register to attend the Clean and Green Riverfest on or before 11:59 PM (MT) on September 17, 2026.

Prize winners will be contacted by 11:59 p.m. (MT) on October 2, 2026.

PRIZE

There is one prize available to be won, consisting of: gift cards to locally owned St. Albert restaurants and Mission Fun and Games.

The prize will be randomly awarded to one separate eligible Contest entrant. The prize must be accepted as awarded. The prize is not redeemable for cash or credit, in whole or in part. Some restrictions apply. No substitution or transfer of prizes are allowed except at the discretion of the Contest Sponsor. In order to receive their prize, the Contest winner must correctly complete a mathematical skill-testing question and sign a standard declaration and release form confirming compliance with the Contest rules together with a consent for the City of St. Albert to use the winner’s name and likeness online, in print, and in any other media in connection with the Contest and for advertising and promotional purposes without further notice or additional compensation. The prizes winners agree to cooperate with the Sponsor in arranging for photographs or other forms of publicity and to be available for photographs or other forms of publicity on reasonable notice.

The Contest winner is responsible for picking up the prizes during normal weekday business hours within 14 days of the draw. Noncompliance within this time period may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner(s).

THE DRAW

The prize winner will be randomly selected from all eligible entries received during the Contest Period. The prizes draw will be conducted by the Sponsor no later than 11:59 p.m. (MT) on October 2, 2026 in St. Albert, Alberta. The selected winner will be notified by phone call and email by the contact information provided by the registrant.

Return of any prize notification as undeliverable or failure of the prize winner to successfully answer the skill-testing question within 30 days of notification of selection may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner.

ODDS

The chances of winning are dependent on the total number of eligible entries received during the Contest Period.

ELIGIBILITY

This contest is open to individuals who are residents of Alberta and are 18 years of age or older by midnight on the last day of the Contest Period.

Contest participants are responsible to ensure that their email and phone privacy settings do not prevent the Sponsor from contacting them in the event they are selected as a winner. Noncompliance with this requirement may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner(s).

This contest is not open to employees or the Mayor and Councillors of the City of St. Albert.

GENERAL

This Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. By entering the Contest, participants agree to be bound by these official Contest rules and the terms and conditions under which the prizes is awarded.

If, for any reason, this Contest is not capable of being completed as planned by the Sponsor including, but not limited, to computer virus, bugs, tampering, technical failures or other causes beyond the control of the Sponsor, the Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel or suspend this Contest or modify the Contest rules at any time. Further, the Sponsor generally reserves the right not to award a prize. The Sponsor may make substitutions of equivalent kind or value in the event of the unavailability of a prize (or component thereof) for any reason whatsoever. The Sponsor may terminate or withdraw this Contest at any time by posting a notice online. If the Contest is terminated on any day prior to the last day of the Contest Period (the "Termination Date"), the Sponsor may determine the winner from all eligible entries received as of 5:00 PM (MT) on the Termination Date (which winner shall be randomly selected in accordance with these Contest rules).

USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

By entering the Contest and voluntarily providing their personal information, including photos of themselves as well as their dependents, all participants agree to the collection, use and disclosure by the Sponsor, and its respective employees and/or authorized agents, of participants' personal information for the purpose of administering the Contest, including, but not limited to, contacting selected winners. By entering the Contest, all participants agree to the use of their photos, videos, name, and likeness by the Sponsor online, in print, and in any other media in connection with the Contest and for marketing and promotional purposes. Personally-identifiable information will only be used to administer the Contest and for no other purpose, except as specifically outlined in

these Contest rules. Personally-identifiable information will not be sold, shared or disclosed by the Sponsor or a third party engaged by the Sponsor for the purpose of administering the Contest. Participants' personal information is being collected under the authority of section 33(c) of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. F-25. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY/RELEASE

By participating in the Contest, and as a condition of acceptance of the prize, participants release and forever discharge and hold harmless the City of St. Albert and its employees, officers, directors, agents, parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, and representatives (collectively, the "Released Parties"), from and against any and all liability or any losses, damages (including, without limitation, direct, indirect, incidental, consequential or punitive damages), rights, claims, actions, causes of action, personal injury, property damage or death, including without limitation all costs and liabilities of any kind including legal fees on a substantial indemnity scale, hereinafter called "Claims", and including without limitation any claims arising from any act of negligence of the Released Parties, that participants now have, or may hereafter have against the Released Parties directly or indirectly resulting or arising from: (i) participation in the Contest, or the awarding, acceptance, possession, use, or misuse or enjoyment of any prize, and where applicable, traveling to, preparing for, or participating in, any Contest-related or Prize-related event or activity; or (ii) the publicity rights granted to the Sponsor. In the event that, due to a printing, manufacturing, mechanical or other error of any kind or nature whatsoever, more prizes are claimed than are intended to be awarded according to these Contest rules, prizes will stop being awarded when the Sponsor becomes aware of an error respecting the number of prizes and the Sponsor reserves the right, in their sole and absolute discretion, to conduct a random draw from amongst all eligible and approved prize claimants whose claims

The Sponsor reserves the right to seek remedies and damages from any such individual or entity which makes any such attempt. The Contest is governed by the laws of Alberta and the laws of Canada applicable therein, and is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations and is void where prohibited by law. Participation constitutes your full and unconditional agreement to these Contest rules and the decisions of the Sponsor, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Contest. By entering the Contest, you agree that the courts of Alberta, Canada shall have jurisdiction to entertain any action or other legal proceedings based on any provision of this Contest's Rules or the running of this Contest.
