

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS**

### **Bylaw 6/2021 Land Use Bylaw Schedule B Amendment** **Bylaw 55/2021 Land Use Bylaw Schedule A Redistricting**

**To be conducted via ZOOM electronic meeting during the Regular Meeting of Council scheduled for 2:00 pm on Monday January 31, 2022**

**(The exact time of commencement of these public hearings will depend upon when they arise on the Meeting Agenda)**

In accordance with Section 692 of the *Municipal Government Act* and Alberta Regulation 50/2020, Public Hearings have been scheduled to take place on Monday, January 31, 2022 for Bylaws 6/2021 and 55/2021.

Bylaw 6/2021, if passed, will remove two segments of roadway from Land Use Bylaw Schedule B, and add five segments of roadway to Schedule B. The word “arterial” will also be removed from several sections of the Land Use Bylaw to comply with Complete Streets terminology.

Bylaw 55/2021 if passed, would amend the Land Use Bylaw 9/2005, Schedule A, by redistricting two parcels of land along the south edge of the Cherot neighbourhood to Residential (RX), Residential Lane (RXL), Medium Density Residential (R3A), and Public Park (P).

### **Speaking to City Council at the Public Hearing**

Individuals and Groups wishing to address Council verbally on their own behalf via the electronic ZOOM platform may register with Legislative Services at any time up to 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, January 30, 2022. You must register by email sent to [hearings@stalbert.ca](mailto:hearings@stalbert.ca) containing a request to be registered as a speaker. A reply email will be sent, explaining how to connect to ZOOM for the public hearing.

Individuals wishing to address Council in the capacity of Agent for one or more other persons must register with Legislative Services by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 27, 2022 declaring their intention to act as an Agent at a Public Hearing. A separate, completed, signed, and dated Agent Declaration form for each person being represented must be submitted by the individual being represented (not by the Agent) to Legislative Services at [hearings@stalbert.ca](mailto:hearings@stalbert.ca) and must arrive at that email address by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 27, 2022.

Groups and individuals, including Agents who have registered to represent four or fewer affected parties, shall be allotted a maximum of five minutes to make their presentations. Agents who have registered to represent at least five affected parties shall be allotted a maximum of ten minutes to make their presentations. Council may at any time during a Public Hearing pass a motion to extend time limits.

### **Written Submissions**

Whether or not an individual is also making a verbal presentation, a written submission (including a PowerPoint intended to accompany a verbal presentation) must be emailed to Legislative Services at [hearings@stalbert.ca](mailto:hearings@stalbert.ca) not later than 12:00 noon on Wednesday, January 26, 2022 and must include the name of the person making the submission. Written submissions received by this deadline will be included in the meeting Agenda Package that is distributed to Council members and posted on the City's public website. Persons who have missed the written submission deadline may still make a verbal submission through any method described above. Written submissions received either by administration or by Council after 12:00 noon on Wednesday, January 26, 2022 will not be considered by Council at a Public Hearing.

### **Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act**

If you submit comments on Bylaw 6/2021 or Bylaw 55/2021, either orally or in writing, the information you provide may be recorded in the minutes of the applicable Public Hearing, or otherwise be made public, subject to the provisions of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*.
