STORMWATER MANAGEMENT FACILITIES **NOT SAFE TO RECREATE**

Your community pond has a secret. It's not a pond at all. It's a stormwater management facility and its dangerously deep areas and unpredictable ice thickness makes it unsafe for all activities.

While they may look frozen, stormwater management facilities have water continuously flowing below the ice surface. This means that some areas may have ice while other areas may have little to no ice.
