CONSTRUCTION AND ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE

Starting on **May 3**, a full road closure of Villeneuve Road from east of Dennison Drive to the west side of the Walmart commercial access will commence as construction begins in this area.

The closure is anticipated to be in place until **September 2023**.

Please Note: Both roundabouts in this area will remain open, with only the east-west portion of Villeneuve Road between the two roundabouts closed.

Drivers are encouraged to follow all detour signage onsite or plan alternate routes. We thank you in advance for your cooperation and patience as the City works to complete this necessary work to improve our roadways.
