SUPPORTING WILDFIRE EVACUEES

The City is offering support to wildfire evacuees who have been forced from their homes.

- A temporary RV permitting system has been set up to allow evacuees, who are using RVs or trailers as temporary accommodations, to continuously park in front of family and friends' homes until June 30.
- To register for a temporary parking permit, owners/ occupants of the RV or trailer are asked to call the St. Albert Municipal Enforcement/RCMP non-emergency line at 780-458-7700. Complete details on the Bylaws webpage at stalbert.ca/ bylaws under Recreational Vehicle and Trailer City Wide Temporary Permit.
- Evacuees with a valid photo ID, will get a free play pass to Servus Credit Union Place (400 Campbell Road). To get a play pass, visit the front desk at Servus Place.
