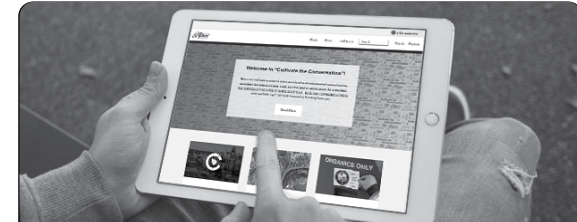
PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

SUPPORTING WILDFIRE EVACUEES

The City is offering support to wildfire evacuees who have been forced from their homes.

- A **temporary RV permitting system** has been set up to allow evacuees, who are using RVs or trailers as temporary accommodations, to continuously park in front of family and friends' homes until **June 30**.
- To register for a temporary parking permit, owners/occupants of the RV or trailer are asked to call the St. Albert Municipal Enforcement/RCMP non-emergency line at **780-458-7700**. Complete details on the Bylaws webpage at stalbert.ca/bylaws under Recreational Vehicle and Trailer City Wide Temporary Permit.
- Evacuees with a valid photo ID, will get a **free play pass** to **Servus Credit Union Place** (400 Campbell Road). To get a play pass, visit the front desk at Servus Place.
