Do you need to get rid of an old couch or dishwasher? Drop off your oversized items at the Large Item Drop Off Event at the Jack Kraft parking lot (7 Chevigny Street) from **8 a.m.** to **2 p.m.** on **Saturday, September 16**.

Note: Each item requires two "Extra Garbage" tags which must be purchased and attached to your item prior to the event. Tags can be purchased at Servus Credit Union Place or St Albert Place.

NOTICE OF BLUE GREEN ALGAE AT LACOMBE LAKE

Blue green algae is very toxic, so please keep children, dogs and other pets away. The City is monitoring the situation. Access is suspended until further notice and the dog beach gate is closed.

This type of bacteria starts growing during hot summer months, and flourishes in extreme heat temperatures on the surface of waters in Alberta. Tips for dealing with Blue Green Algae:

- Treat all blue green algae with caution
- Do not drink water from lakes, rivers, and reservoirs with visible blooms
- Do not swim or wade in water containing the algae
- Keep pets out of the water and provide alternative sources of drinking water when outside on walks
