PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

CHANGES TO RECYCLING PROGRAM FEES

As of **May 1**, recycling program fees will be reduced from 6.54 to 1.40 per month. This change is due to the new Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) regulations.

The City is recovering the maximum amount of costs possible through the EPR and stewardship programs to decrease rates for residents.
