Note: Each item requires two “Extra Garbage” tags which must be purchased and attached to your item prior to the event. Tags can be purchased at Servus Credit Union Place, Fountain Park Recreation Centre or St. Albert Place (St. Albert Place is closed for construction **Aug. 29 to Sept. 5**).
