- Local tickets are sold in booklets of 10 for \$25.50. Commuter tickets are sold in booklets of 10 for \$43.20.

- Fare is required upon entry for each trip. Do not “owe” the fare or pay in advance for the second trip.
- For clients requiring a mandatory attendant, the mandatory attendant must travel with the client at all times and will ride for free.
- A fare is required from all companions (friends or family) accompanying registered clients on the Handibus.
- St. Albert Transit monthly passes, including U-Pass and All Aboard (AISH) passes, are NOT accepted on Handibus.

Wheelchair and Scooter Specifications

- All wheelchairs, walkers and scooters transported on the Handibus must meet specific size, weight and safety guidelines.
- Mobility aids must be kept in good repair at all times and have functioning brakes.
- No flags or projections are permitted.

MAXIMUM WEIGHT AND BASE DIMENSIONS

The combined weight of the chair (or scooter) and passenger **cannot exceed 750 lbs (340 kg)** in total weight.

For wheelchairs, walkers and scooters the **maximum base dimensions are 34 x 48 Inches (86 x 122 cm)**.

*Equipment larger than this cannot be accommodated.*

Handibus Clients and Conventional Transit Service

All of St. Albert’s conventional transit service is fully accessible with low floor buses. Accessible buses permit easy entry by persons using wheelchairs, scooters or those with mobility restrictions and operate on all local transit routes and on commuter routes to and from Edmonton.

A registered Handibus client may bring along a companion (friend or family member) when riding conventional transit. The companion would ride for free.

St. Albert Transit Handibus is a service designed to assist in meeting the mobility needs of City of St. Albert residents, 16 years of age and over, who cannot use regular accessible transit services due to a physical or cognitive disability.

Eligibility

Handibus service is available to any St. Albert resident 16 years of age and over, who is unable to utilize existing fully-accessible conventional public transit due to a physical or cognitive disability. All Handibus clients must be registered with St. Albert Transit prior to booking a trip.

Registration Process

- Registration forms are available online at [ridestat.ca](http://ridestat.ca) or at the St. Albert Transit Office, 235 Carnegie Drive, St. Albert.
- Part A of the registration form is to be completed by patron or by a legal guardian.
  - Part B of the registration form is to be completed by a qualified medical practitioner (Medical Doctor, Registered Nurse, etc.) to verify medical reasons for not being able to access conventional transit services.

- Once completed, return the application form in one of the following ways:

Arrangements will be made for an in-person assessment appointment to review the application form, explain the Handibus service and to take a photo for the issuance of a photo ID registrant card if deemed eligible. Applicant will be notified by letter if they are or are not eligible for the Handibus Service.

Types of Trips

Reservation Trips

Casual trips booked one to three days in advance.

Subscription Trips

Identical trips going from the same origin to the same destination at the same time and day of the week for a minimum of 6 weeks in duration (for example: every Monday and Thursday to the same physiotherapy clinic). Once booked, subscription services run as long as needed.

Same Day Trips

Subject to availability.

Services Available

Automated Reminder Phone Calls

A phone call will be made to you the evening prior to your scheduled trip, and again 5 to 10 minutes prior to the actual pickup time. Clients can utilize the “evening before” phone call to cancel the next day’s trip if necessary. Clients can opt out of reminder phone calls.
