Cleaning up your yard this fall? Curbside Leaf Pick Up runs from:

- **Tuesday, September 15 to Friday, September 18**
- **Tuesday, October 27 to Friday, October 30**

Look for the leaf symbol on the Waste Collection Calendar for these dates. Leaves must be in paper yard waste bags or reusable containers and weigh less than 50 pounds. Place at curbside by **7 a.m.** on the **Tuesday** of your collection week. Leaves in plastic bags will not be collected.
