## Hockey Cohort Structure:

- Participants must first register for a sport cohort and then will be able to pre-register up to 7 days in advance for any individual session within that cohort. All of this can be done online, in person, or over the phone
- As per AHS guidelines, individuals may only register for and play within one sport cohort at a time
- Players are not able to arrive at the arena any earlier than 30 minutes prior to their session starting, and are asked to leave as quickly as possible afterwards
- Dressing rooms are available but players are asked to come as prepared as possible. Showers are not available
- Maximum 20 players and 2 goalies per session
- Full hockey equipment is mandatory: hockey helmet with ½ visor (full face mask and neck guard recommended, all helmets must have a strap and both parts of the buckle), shoulder pads, hockey pants, hockey gloves, shin and elbow pads, and regulation ice hockey stick
- No body contact allowed
- Players must rotate shifts to allow fair ice time

**There is a zero tolerance policy for all individuals (players and spectators). Swearing, fighting, refusing to show ID, sneaking on the ice, and being disrespectful will result in immediate dismissal.**

**It is everyone's responsibility to ensure they are compliant with all AHS guidelines. Any participants exhibiting signs related to COVID-19 will be asked to leave by a Servus Credit Union staff member.**

## Public Skating Rules and Expectations:

- Pre-registration is required for every session and must be completed for each individual going onto the ice. This can be done up to 7 days in advance online at [www.servusplace.ca](http://www.servusplace.ca). For cancellations, please call 780-418-6088.
- All individuals must sign in with the Public Skating Attendants prior to entering the arena. Photo ID will be required for one person in each group to confirm the booking.
- Masks or face coverings (must cover the mouth and nose) are required inside the facility, including in the dressing rooms and on the bench. Participants may remove masks or face coverings when they are on the ice.
- There is a maximum of 30 participants allowed at each Public Skating session. Participants are asked to come dressed for the activity and ready to participate.
- Participants are to skate in the direction determined by the Public Skating Attendants. The direction will be switched midway through the session.
- Participants are expected to maintain physical distancing at all times. This includes in the arena, in the dressing rooms, on the bench, and on the ice.
- Children under 8 years of age must be actively supervised by a responsible individual 13 years of age or older.
- Helmets are recommended and not provided.
- Sticks and pucks, shinny, and figure skating are not permitted on the ice.
- Chairs, strollers, shoes, sleds, and skate aids are not permitted on the ice.
