## **Purpose**

To reduce the impact of increases in municipal property taxation for eligible senior homeowners by establishing a framework for a fixed grant to eligible households.

## **Policy**

The City shall provide a Senior Homeowners Property Tax Assistance Grant to eligible households.

## **Standards**

- 1. The City shall undertake the primary role in the administration and delivery of the program, and the Government of Alberta's role shall be limited to the provision of required *Alberta Senior's Benefit* information.
- 2. Specific program eligibility shall be determined by Council, and is to be based on the qualifications outlined by the Government of Alberta's *Alberta Seniors Benefit* program.
- 3. The City shall receive from the Government of Alberta by May 15 of each year, a list of St. Albert households, who are currently receiving the *Alberta Senior's Benefit*. This list forms the basis of eligibility for the Senior Homeowner Property Tax Assistance Grant for the tax year.
- 4. The City shall provide a flat grant amount to each eligible household, in the form of a tax credit applied to the property tax account pertaining to the eligible household's primary St. Albert residence. The grant amount is limited to one per household per tax year.
- 5. The amount of the grant and funding for the City's grant will be established annually through the Municipal Operating Budget.
- 6. Administration shall report to Council annually, providing details on the number of grants issued and total program expenditure.
