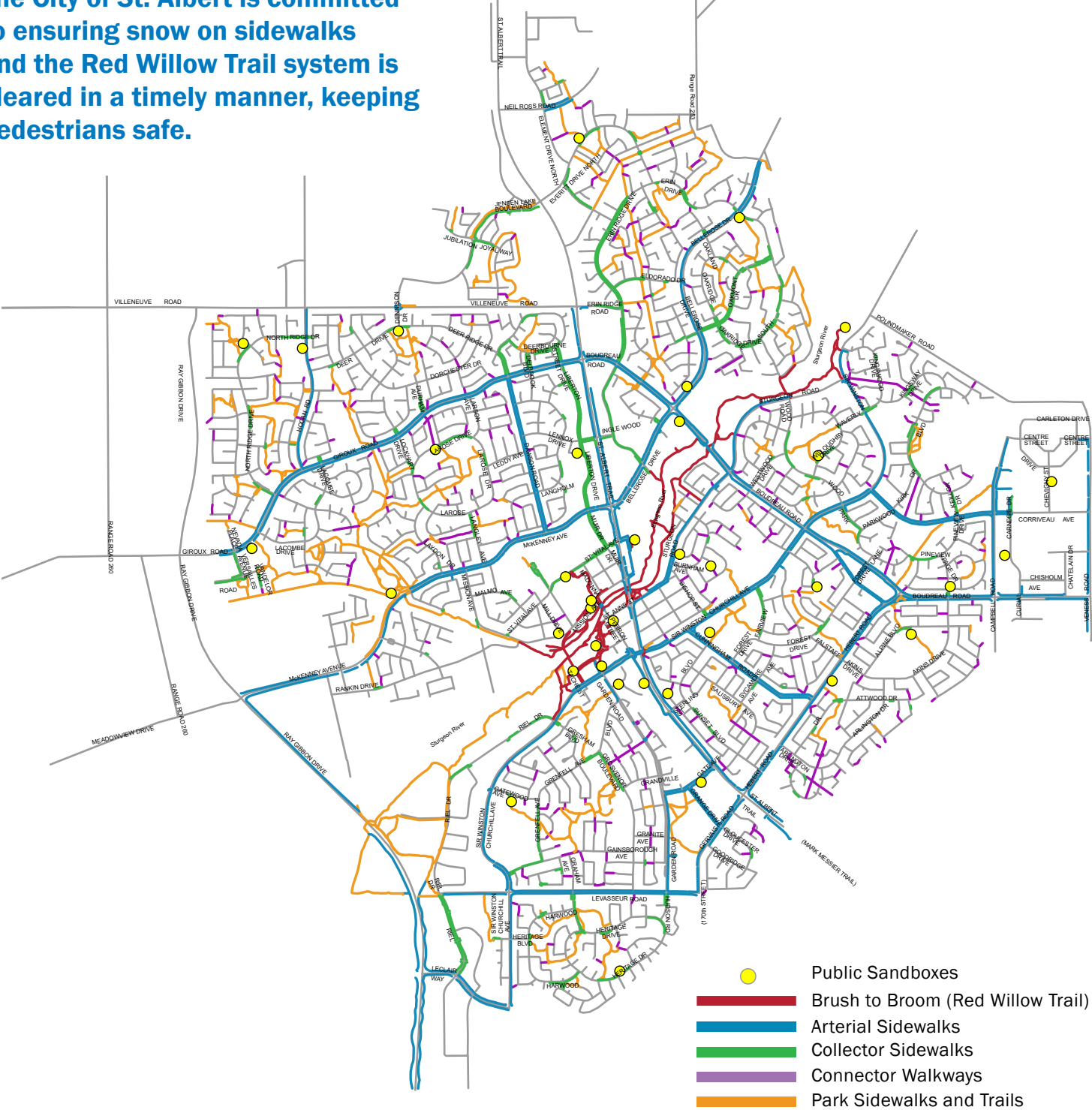


# 2023 – 2024 Snow Clearing | Sidewalks & Trails

## SIDEWALKS AND TRAILS MAINTENANCE MAP

The City of St. Albert is committed to ensuring snow on sidewalks and the Red Willow Trail system is cleared in a timely manner, keeping pedestrians safe.



### Sidewalk and Trail Clearing

Sidewalks and trails that run through the river valley, by transit terminals or adjacent to civic buildings are considered the priorities. Sections of trail and sidewalk will be maintained in the priority sequence outlined in the table below.

Please report unsafe road conditions, such as icy roads or damaged traffic signs, by calling Public Operations at 780-459-1557.

PRIORITY	AREA	SNOW CLEARING ACTIVITIES
		Please note: Snow clearing will follow the priority sequence below until all areas have been addressed. However, in the event of a recurring or prolonged snowfall, resources may be re-allocated to the higher priority areas.
1	Brush to Broom (Red Willow Trail)	<b>Swept</b> to a snow free surface within 8 hours after 1 cm of snow accumulation
2	Arterial Sidewalks	<b>Plowing</b> within 48 hours after 2 - 5 cm of snow accumulation
2	Collector Sidewalks	<b>Plowing</b> within 48 hours after 2 - 5 cm of snow accumulation
3	Connector Walkways	<b>Plowing</b> within 72 hours after 2 - 5 cm of snow accumulation and after the completion of priorities 1 and 2
3	Park Sidewalks and Trails	<b>Plowing</b> within 72 hours after 2 - 5 cm of snow accumulation and after the completion of priorities 1 and 2
