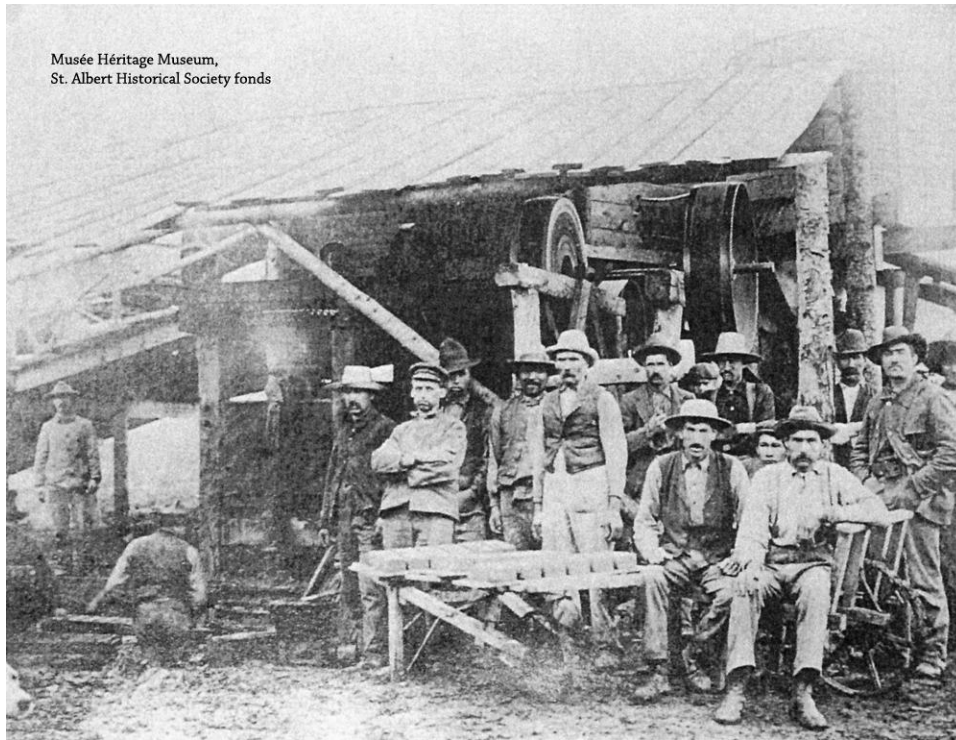


St. Albert Brickyard



The St. Albert Brickyard, owned by Fleuri Perron, operated from about 1903 - 1932. It was located an eighth of a mile east [of downtown] on North River Road and employed approximately twenty men. Perron had also been involved in running a local hotel and general store. He would eventually go on to serve on the first Council for St. Albert and be elected as Mayor in 1907. He would sell the business to Herbert Jacobs.
