

St. Albert Arena (Ducky Dome)



When faced with a lack of recreational infrastructure to support a growing population in the 1960s, the Town of St. Albert approved the building of the St. Albert Arena in 1969. The arena, located in downtown St. Albert, officially opened in 1971. In 1984 artist Grant Leier painted a mural of ducks on the back wall of the arena, resulting in the nickname, Ducky Dome. The building was demolished in 1992 when St. Albert began plans for a twin-ice arena.
