

## Interurban Railway



The company of businessman Raymond Brutinel, built a passenger rail link between St. Albert and Edmonton in 1912. The first passenger service began a year later using gas-electric cars. Unfortunately the interurban was destined to be short-lived. In April 1914 a fire in the engine shed destroyed the only two cars. There were plans to re-start the rail service but the First World War started and Brutinel left St. Albert to serve in France.
