



Off-Leash Area Guidelines

1. The behaviour of your dog is your responsibility.
2. Ensure you know the boundaries of the off-leash area. Dogs must be on a leash when entering or leaving off-leash area boundaries, or when on trails that cut through an off-leash area.
3. Dog poop must be picked up immediately and owners must always carry a means of picking up after their dog. It's not just the right thing to do, it's the law!
4. Dogs over 6 months of age must be licensed and remain under owner's complete control.
5. Areas are on-leash when organized sporting activities are taking place.
6. Not everyone is comfortable around dogs. Dogs are prohibited from being in playground areas even when on a leash.
