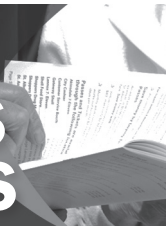

### BYLAW 8/2018 BEING AMENDMENT 4 TO OFFSITE LEVY BYLAW 30/2013

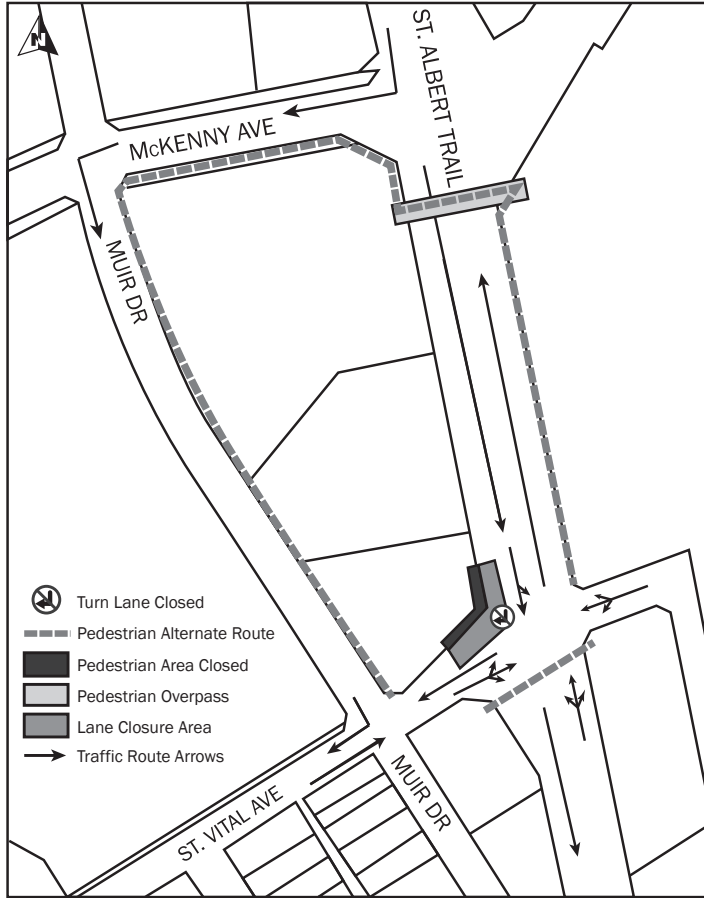
TAKE NOTICE that in accordance with Section 648 of the *Municipal Government Act* notice is hereby given of the intent of the Municipal Council of the City of St. Albert to consider an amendment to Bylaw 30/2013 a Bylaw to establish Offsite Levies for Sanitary Sewer, Storm Sewer, Water and Roadways.

Bylaw 8/2018, being Amendment 4 to Off-Site Levy Bylaw 30/2013 will be presented to Council on March 19, 2018. The purpose of this Bylaw is to update the project list and the rates within the Bylaw.

**March 6 to end of June**

There will be a temporary lane closure off St. Albert Trail southbound to westbound St. Vital Avenue. No right turns will be permitted due to construction. Detour: Please use McKenney Avenue and Muir Drive to travel westbound on St. Vital. Lane closure due to Project 9 construction and installation of a shaft that will be used to launch tunneling equipment and pipes. Please obey all signage.

## SPOTLIGHT ON

### REMINDER ABOUT ICY SIDEWALKS

St. Albert Community Standards Bylaw 12/2010 requires residents to eliminate dangerous conditions on sidewalks.

There are several ways to do this:

- Shovel, sweep or clear away any snow that might freeze to form ice.
- Use de-icers or chipping tools to clear away ice.

Here are some helpful tips to make the job a bit easier:

- Spray your shovel blade with cooking oil to keep snow from sticking.
- Clear snow right after it falls, before anyone can walk or drive on it.
- Spread sand on your sidewalk before ice forms and builds up.
- Microwave your sand so it will melt snow and ice faster.
- Pile snow in a place where it will not melt onto your driveway or sidewalk during warmer weather.
