### WATER CONSERVATION BYLAW

Municipal Enforcement Services tip: Did you know that from **May 1 to October 1** (high outdoor water-use months), municipal supplied water from a hose, pipe, sprinkler or permanent irrigation system is permitted only between **7 p.m. and 9 a.m.**? This helps reduce water loss due to evaporation and maximizes the benefits to grass and plants.

### NOTICE TO LACOMBE DOG PARK USERS

The City of St. Albert is planning to remove invasive goldfish at Lacombe Lake Park the week of **September 4**. A follow-up treatment is scheduled between **September 18 and 25**. The treatment is not harmful to humans, pets or other wildlife.

The goldfish removal activities will affect the use of the dog park and beach.

- The entrance by the gazebo will be closed for approximately eight hours during the treatment and will reopen when complete.
- The dog beach and lake access will be closed for 72 hours following treatment.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for Bylaw 332011, being Amendment 60 to Land Use Bylaw 92005. Bylaw 332011 is a bylaw to re-designate a portion of NE 1/4 SEC 7, TWP 54, RGE 25, W4M, known municipally as 8 Genstar Annex or North Ridge Stage 25, from Urban Reserve (UR) to Low Density Residential (R1) and Park (P) for the purpose of single family residential use.

### ADDRESSING BYLAW – HOME OWNERS

St. Albert's Addressing Bylaw ensures all addresses are clearly visible from the road year-round. Own your home? Ensure your address complies.

- Make sure your address is not blocked by trees or covered by snow in the winter.
- Address numbers should contrast from the background.
- For a typical house, the address numbers should be at least as tall as a can of pop.
- If you have a back lane, ensure your address is clearly visible from the lane as well.

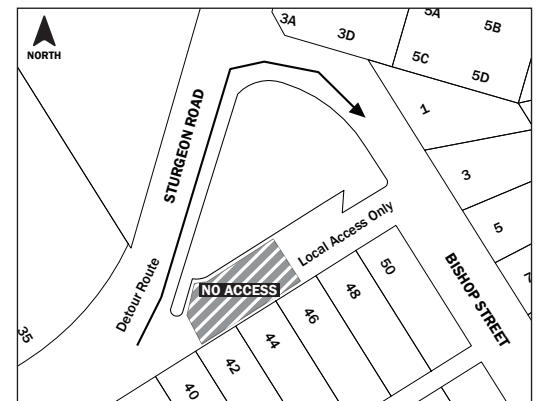
### GROSVENOR OUTDOOR POOL SURVEY
