SPOTLIGHT ON

INDOOR FIRE SAFETY – CANDLES

Candles are an important part of many winter festivals. Follow these tips to use candles safely:

- When in use, keep matches and lighters away from kids.
- Store matches and lighters where they won't be found by curious children.
- Do not place lit candles in locations that are easily reached by children.
- Do not place candles in a location where they might be knocked over by children, pets or adults as they pass by.
- Extinguish candles when leaving the room, leaving home or going to sleep.
- Do not place lit candles near flammable objects such as toys, clothes, books, paper decorations or trees.
- Do not place candles near windows, where the candles might be blown over, or where curtains or blinds might catch fire.
