NOTICE SIDEWALK CLOSURE – USE ALTERNATE ROUTES

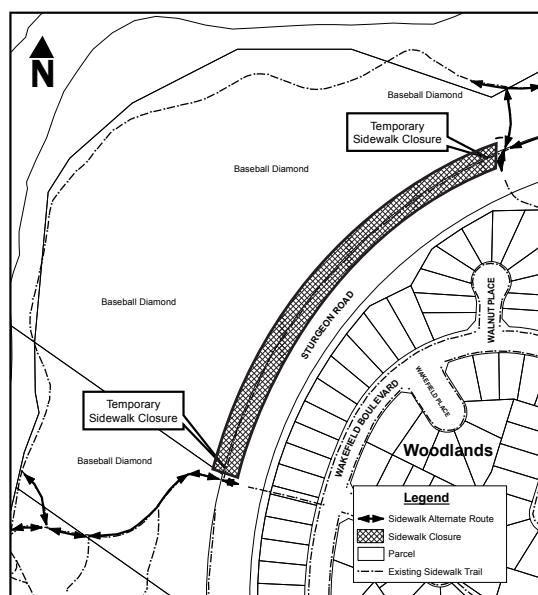
SIDEWALK CLOSURE PORTION OF STURGEON ROAD

SPOTLIGHT ON

INDOOR FIRE SAFETY – COOKING

As you prepare your holiday meals during the festive season, make sure an unwanted fire in the kitchen doesn't ruin your special day!

Take these precautions to keep everyone safe:

- Pay close attention to what you have cooking in the oven or on the stove.
- Keep pot handles turned inwards toward the stove. This will prevent you from accidentally bumping the handles as you walk by. It will also prevent children from pulling down on the handles, tipping the pot over and spilling the hot contents.
- Keep a pot lid and an oven mitt close to the stove.
- If you experience a small pan fire on the top of the stove, put on the oven mitt, grab the lid and use it to smother the fire. Once the lid is in place, be sure to turn the stove element to off. Do not move the pan to another location – you might spill the contents onto your clothes or the hot element.

- If a fire starts inside the oven, leave the door closed and turn off the oven. Do not open the door – this will add air to the fire and the fire will grow.
- Keep flammable objects away from the stove so they don't catch on fire – these include tea towels, aprons and paper decorations.
- If your clothes do catch on fire, remember to stop, drop and roll to put out the flames.
