CALL FOR ARTISTS

CALL TO EMERGING VISUAL ARTISTS: *BUTTERFLIES IN THE PARK, ST. ALBERT* ART IN PUBLIC PLACES

This opportunity is meant to inspire emerging artists to create public art for our city. We know applying to one of our public art calls can be an intimidating process, but this is a chance for those with no or little experience in the public art field to explore creating long-term pieces for their community.

Eligible artists are living in, studying in or exhibiting art in St. Albert. "Emerging Artist" means artists with less than five years professional practice, which means that if you work well collaboratively and make art, you need no experience as a professional artist. High school and university students are encouraged to apply!

We are looking for two artists to create one small 3D butterfly-inspired artwork each to be temporarily installed for two years in the St. Albert Botanic Park. The City will be responsible for installing the artworks.

We are looking for PORTABLE two-dimensional artworks in any medium for installation in public buildings operated by the City of St. Albert.

The City of St. Albert collects artwork that demonstrates the vitality and innovation of the region's visual art community. Purchase decisions are based on a two-stage process according to jury recommendations, with artwork acquired through the program becoming part of the City of St. Albert Public Art Collection. Public Art acquisition is funded through the City of St. Albert's Policy.

This is Part One of a two-part selection process. The objective of this pre-qualification process will be to compile a list of potential acquisitions as selected from the visual material provided by the artists or the artists' representatives.

SPOTLIGHT ON

GARAGE SALE SIGNS

Are you planning a garage sale so you can do some spring cleaning? If so, you should know the rules for placing garage sale signs on boulevards in your neighbourhood. As long as you stay off private property, the City of St. Albert will allow residents to temporarily post garage sale signs on City-owned property.

All you have to do is follow a few simple guidelines. Ensure the sign is less than 1.0 m high and 0.6 m wide; is self-supported; and is put up and taken down within 24 hours of the garage sale. In addition, the sign cannot be within 30.5 m of an intersection, or interfere with vehicle or pedestrian traffic.

Note: A person is permitted to hold a maximum of three garage sales per calendar year. After three garage sales, the person must apply for a Business Licence and the appropriate Development Permits.

MONTHLY UTILITY E-BILLING

Starting **July 1**, the City will be moving to monthly paperless utility bills.

What that means to you:

- Still receiving paper bills? You must sign up for e-billing by **July 1**.
- Already signed up for e-billing? No action required.

Residents, without home Internet access, can apply for the exemption program. Residents, with home Internet access, who choose to continue to receive mailed paper utility bills will be charged \$1.02 per bill, starting **July 1**. This is a cost recovery fee.

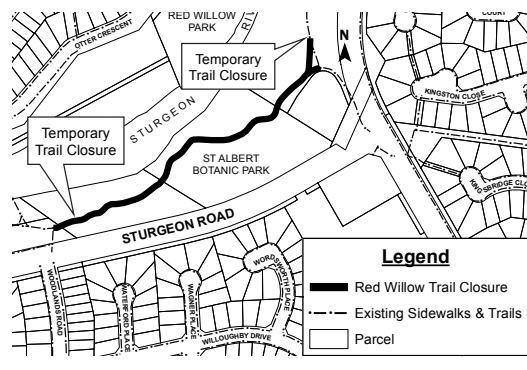
NOTICE TRAIL CLOSURE – RED WILLOW TRAIL

DOG-FRIENDLY PARKS AND OFF-LEASH AREAS

Looking for a fun place for your dog to run and play off-leash? Take them to one of St. Albert's Dog-Friendly Parks – Dodger Dog Park or Lacombe Lake Dog Park.

Dodger Dog Friendly-Park is located on the north side of 400 Campbell Road near Servus Credit Union Place. It is a great place for your dog to run and play off-leash while you enjoy the natural setting and socialize with other dog owners!

Lacombe Lake Dog-Friendly Park is located at 151 McKenney Ave. It features a fenced, off-leash area, pond, and treed walking trails. Please remember that all dogs must be on-leash when outside of the designated dog-friendly park.

There are also many off-leash sites (including outdoor rinks) that are available for dogs when not in use by a sporting activity!

When using off-leash areas, please remember:

- Dog feces must be picked up immediately when not on an owner's property
- Dogs must be licensed and remain under the owner's control.
- Walkers must carry a leash at all times. Trails are on-leash.
- Entire areas is on-leash when organized sporting activities are taking place.
- Dogs are not allowed in playground areas.
