MONTHLY UTILITY E-BILLING – EXEMPTION PROGRAM

Don't have home Internet service? Apply for the exemption program. Exemption forms are now available at Utilities Services, Main Floor, City Hall. Fill out the form and either drop it off or mail it back by **June 17**, so you can continue to receive a paper bill on **July 1**. Exemption forms must be submitted two weeks prior to the next billing date. With your exemption, you'll continue to receive paper utility bills at no cost.

CARE ABOUT AIR!

St. Albert has an Idle-Free Bylaw to reduce idling and help residents better understand how they can impact air quality.

The Idle-Free Bylaw limits idling of parked vehicles to 3 minutes at any time.

Natural Resources Canada recommends turning off your engine if stopped for more than 60 seconds (except in traffic). Such as dropping off or waiting for passengers or running into the convenience store or bank.

ROTATIONAL RE-INSPECTION NOTICE

The City of St. Albert Assessment Department will be conducting rotational re-inspections of residential homes in several St. Albert neighbourhoods during the months of April to October 2019. These re-inspections are permissible in accordance with Section 294 of the Municipal Government Act.

Assessors will be conducting re-inspections primarily in the following neighbourhoods:

- Lacombe Park
- Oakmont
- Akinsdale

If you are away from your home on the day the property assessor calls, they may leave a yellow **Notice for Assessment** card on your door or in your mailbox, with instructions to telephone our department.

All property assessors working in your neighbourhood will be carrying City of St. Albert identification.

- The re-inspection of your property may include a brief interior walk through of your home or a doorstep interview.
- Property re-inspections typically take only 10 minutes.
- Property re-inspection programs are a common element within the annual property assessment process.
- Property re-inspections help us to ensure we have accurate data about your home, so that it can be fairly valued for assessment & taxation purposes.
- Our goal is to ensure accuracy, fairness, and equity in the preparation of your annual assessment.

OHV REGULATIONS

With the approach of summer, many residents are looking forward to using their recreational vehicles. Did you know that the use of off-highway vehicles (OHV) is not allowed within St. Albert? The only exceptions are for loading and unloading these vehicles into your truck or onto your trailer. Examples of off-highway vehicles are all-terrain vehicles (ATVs), commonly known as quads, and snowmobiles. Residents are asked to enjoy these vehicles in approved areas only! The City of St. Albert's Traffic Bylaw 18/2005 provides more details on the types of vehicles defined as off-highway and not permitted for use within the city limits.
