Frequently Asked Questions

Following are some questions that parents may have about the programs that we offer. If after reading this, you still have more questions please do not hesitate to contact our program staff at 780-418-6088.

Can you tell me more about your summer staff?

We employ as many as 30 recreation program leaders to lead our camp activities. Our team members are chosen because they enjoy working with kids, have positive previous experiences with children, and are creative and fun.

Camp staff hold current certificates in First Aid, CPR, and complete a security clearance. Some staff will have extra certifications based on the programs that they are leading, but these basics are required for all staff working with children. As part of their standard orientation, staff receive training in Fundamental Movement Skills, appropriate conduct with children, behaviour management techniques, emergency procedures, resource building and more that assist in creating the most fun and safe experience for your child.

What facilities do you offer programs?

Summer programs are offered at a variety of locations throughout the city, including **Servus Credit Union Place** and a variety of clubhouses and local parks. Please carefully read the program guide and your confirmation letter to confirm the program location where you are registering your child.

- Servus Place, 400 Campbell Road
- Grandin Clubhouse, 5 Grenfell Avenue

Servus Place has a variety of amenities available for camps to utilize throughout each day, which includes the field houses, gymnasiums, multi-purpose rooms, kitchen, preschool room and aquatic centre. Camps will also use outdoor parks, playgrounds, walking trails and natural spaces. Not all groups will use every space, as camps will use spaces that are appropriate for the age and program content.

What information is needed before camp starts?

All participants are required to complete a Participant Consent Form at the start of their first summer program. Only one form is required for each participant for the entire summer season. The form can be found at servusplace.ca.

What staffing ratios are used in your programs?

We take great pride in offering you and your child our safest and most enjoyable program opportunities. One key component to offering safe programs is effective supervision. We maintain the following staff to camper ratios:

- 3 to 5 years of age – 1:8
- 6 to 8 years of age – 1:10
- 9 to 12 years of age – 1:12

What should my child bring to camp each day?

Every day, participants should bring the following items in a backpack (that they can comfortably carry – please make sure that all items are clearly labelled with their name). It is also very important to ensure your child is dressed in appropriate clothing each day, as they may be participating in messy, hands on activities, and will be going outside. Other important items include:

- indoor shoes
- a water bottle
- sunscreen and bug spray
- a hat
- Full and 3/4 day camps – *two snacks and a healthy and complete lunch
- Half day camps – *one snack

*Please remember Servus Place is a nut-free/allergy aware facility when preparing food items. Additionally, please do not send money with campers for them to purchase their lunch as this is not permitted.

Please do not send money or anything of value with your child to camp.

Where do I drop off and pick up my child each day?

Please be sure to carefully read your program receipt to ensure that you are dropping off and picking up your child at the correct facility for each program that they are registered in. Campers can be dropped off as early as 10 minutes prior to the start of their camp at the location indicated on your program receipt.

We appreciate parents and caregivers picking up their child(ren) promptly at the assigned pick up time and location as indicated on the confirmation email and Parent Letter.

Is there pre and post camp care available for my child?

Pre and post care are available only at **Servus Place full-day camps** from 8:00 – 8:50 am and 4:00 – 5:00 pm for \$30.00/week. Participants are offered a variety of activity choices in pre and post care including quiet activities, board games, stories, and arts and crafts in the Active Living Centre located on the second floor.

PLEASE NOTE: Pre care is only available for ¾ day camps and morning preschool camps. Post-care is only available for afternoon preschool camps.

What will their program schedule look like for the week?

The Thursday before camp starts, an email with a link to the Parent Letter, along with the Participant Consent Form, will be emailed to each participant. The Parent Letter outlines the schedule of the week's activities and any special items required (e.g. swimsuit). A copy of the Parent Letter and Participant Consent Form will also be available on the first day of camp.

Will my child be going on a field trip in camp?

Field trips will be a part of select **Servus Place full-day camps**. If a camp is going on a field trip it will be interacted in the camp description, or appear on the camp's Parent Letter. Full-day Community Camps may not go on a field trip unless specified or in the program description. Due to the shorter program day and the safety ratios required, ½ and ¾ day camps do not go on field trips. All of our field trips, aside from our park visits, will travel via yellow bus or on the St. Albert Transit bus.

Will my child be swimming at camp?

Each full-day and ¾ day camp at Servus Place and in the community will have at least one recreational swim per week.

NOTE: Half-day programs do not swim.

Can an individual participate in a program/camp if they are living with a disability?

If you or your child are participating in our programs/camps and require any supports or accommodations, please contact our programming staff at 780-418-6088 at your earliest convenience so that we may work together to create the best possible experience. Please let us know at the time of registration if you or your child has any health concerns.

What should I do if my child has a special medical concern or if they require medication during the program day?

It is in the best interest of your child if you **notify our staff at the time of registration** of any behavioural or medical needs that your child may have. This information will help us ensure the best camp experience for them. Any medications that need to be administered during the day also need to be identified at time of registration and confirmed with camp staff on their first day of camp. We do not administer medication for children, and therefore children must be able to administer on their own. Please note we are an “allergy aware” facility, but cannot control allergenic items due to the public nature of our facilities.

What if my child is being bullied in the program?

We have zero tolerance on bullying in our programs. As such, if you or your child has any concerns about bullying in program, we ask that you bring this to the attention of the program coordinators as soon as possible. We will work with the staff and the children involved to immediately resolve the situation. Camp should be a fun and safe place for all children and as such it is our constant goal to ensure that no child is being bullied in our program.

What do you do if there are weather warnings during the program day?

We have best practices in place to address weather issues or weather warnings during program. These best practices are in place to ensure the safety of all participants and our staff while in program. We recommend that all campers come prepared for different summer weather conditions as the weather is very unpredictable.
