Free Activities:

Recreation Bags



Recreation Equipment is available to borrow from the City. There are 10 assorted recreation bags that include a variety of equipment and games. The bags are first-come-first-serve. Book your bag when you register your party.

Fire Permits



If you plan to gather around a portable fire pit during your block party, a Fire Pit Permit is required. You must have permission from the St. Albert Fire Department to use portable devices on your front lawn, driveway or street. You can download the form online or call the fire department at 780-418-6069.

Do It Yourself Art



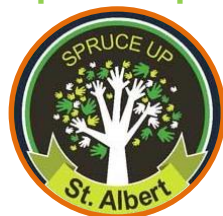

Youth Rewards & Connecting Youth Activities



"Positive Tickets" are available to thank youth who help with your block party. The tickets are provided through the RCMP and can be redeemed for one time use at a City of St. Albert recreation center and a local return trip on St. Albert Transit.

Protect your water! Most stormwater goes to our local river untreated. Yellow Fish can be painted near storm drains in your neighbourhood, reminding people that “Only Rain” down storm drains through the Yellow Fish Road Initiative. Mayor & Council Visits

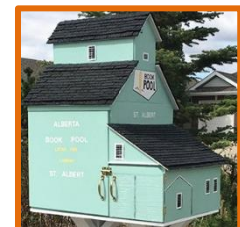
